- conect4children (c4c) network, an Innovative Medicines Initiative 2 (IMI2) funded program
- 20 European countries
- networks rely on experienced and committed leaders

Lack of connecting for ideas of how the young generation sees the future of c4c or c4c-like structures


Overlap in problems and frustrations within each National Network with the same age category


